IF you wish to place vehicle(s) on Conditional Registration through the club, contact the Plate Registrar or Assistant for an information sheet. The club is a participant in the RMS Historic Vehicle Log Book Trial;

THERE are strict policies from the RMS & club regarding use of vehicles on Conditional Registration. Ensure you understand & adhere to them – refer RMS website & The Klaxon.
