

- Have your car inspected by the Club Registrar(s)
- On the 1259 form there is a declaration section (3) for the Registrar to sign off on the car, you will need to pay \$5 for this.
- Also, the car is to be presented to the Registrar(s) to check the eligibility requirements of the HVS scheme.
- The Club will need to keep a copy of the 1259 Form and pink slip if you have one for audit purposes.
