



FYI – If you decide to deviate from a route this will need to be logged and recorded as required by the RMS.For **Non-Club runs** (On the log book system) you **must** record your days use in your log book (including maintenance runs) prior to any departure (only 1 entry per day is required) Concessional system does not require maintenance runs to be recorded but all other drives must be logged in the day book, **Failure** to comply can result in an embarrassing and expensive situation.
