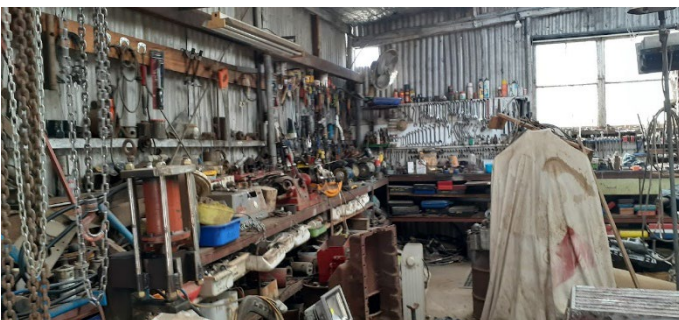
August Events
