Treasurer's Report: Michael Blenkins prepared the Treasurer's Report. The Secretary presented the Report for October, 2024 (in Michael's absence), There was Income from memberships and sponsorship. Payments were for Gallaghers Insurance. In November so far Income was from Memberships. Katopra (\$169.00) was paid using the Debit Card. The Debit Card was replenished.

<u>Motion</u>: That the Treasurer's Report be accepted and the Debit Card account be replenished to reach \$500 limit [\$169].

Moved: Gary ChapmanSeconded: Liz ChapmanMotion: That the Secretary pay the Affiliation fees (around \$100, dependent on members numbers).

<u>Term Deposit</u> – The Treasurer was unable to sort out the Term Deposit by the due date. The Secretary contacted Bendigo Bank in Tumbarumba. [Only one signatory listed (President, Lesley Kell). Secretary (Jennifer Bawden) and Public Officer (Rod Bawden) have added their signatures (same signatures as on Working Account).] Secretary sought to have Term Deposit changed (after due date) as approved at October Meeting (reinvest principal for six months and withdraw accumulated interest). Term changed to six months. The Term Deposit funds will be released on 23/12/24. The GAMC Account is now healthy with the Rego Day memberships being banked.

Point to Point

The key to Point to Point is the payment of a fee.

There is a commissioner for Point to Point which covers all passenger and hire car vehicles.

There are 2000 providers for Point-to-Point vehicles.

If a club vehicle is used for family weddings, or community event, an official letter or invitation must be received by the club and past at a meeting and recorded in the day book. E.g. Anzac Day.

If a letter is received for a wedding or function offering a fee, ego film recording requiring vintage vehicles or wedding outside close family members it then becomes Point to Point.

Recommendation by CHMC in general is not to approve Point to Point use.

Eligibility for Historic registration must be as close to original as possible. Form VS 106/109 from the Transport NSW is the guideline. Seatbelts are still under review.

Australian Taxation Form

Information has been sent out to treasurers and secretaries regarding taxation changes

Mutuality is the important factor. First a club must find out if they have an ABN or a Donation Gift Recipient (DGR) The limit a club can receive as income is \$416 before it becomes taxable. It is advisable to seek an accountant who knows about mutuality

The ATO requires forms to be filled out before the 15th May 2025.

CHMC requests that club information (the JOT form) is sent to them before the 31st December. After each club's AGM club records regarding office bearers and contact details are to be updated and sent to the CHMC.

TNSW requests each club to inform them of who is the registrar, registration officers and scrutineers for their club

CHMC change to constitution. Proposal. That the financial year be change to 1st July to 30th June each year bringing it in line with the normal financial year. To be voted on at Dubbo meeting

Dubbo Rally is to be held 28th/30th March 2025. Entries down to other similar events being held. Members to encourage their clubs to support Dubbo's 60th event

Discussion on future rallies was held as 2026 is vacant.

Rally should be run for fun get togethers not for profit and host club can arrange details on meals and tours. Clubs in favour of entrants taking own meals on runs as catering is a stress for arranging.

Moved that CHMC look into cost of having an independent rally organizer for future rallies

Next AGM of CHMC to be held at Cowra 25th October 2025

Bill Callinan added: CHMC looking at hiring a person to run the rallies, but here will be a charge.

Big clubs have been using their club to launder money. Mutuality is important. All clubs will have to report for this year and the ATO will decide if they have to continue to report.

Laraine Callinan (Observer) added that it was one of the best CHMC meetings she has attended. There was good discussion.

Sponsorship is taxable but can be offset by donation to a registered charity.

General Business

Website Darryl Dunn looked at the website – it is a Google pages website. Without the codes it cannot be accessed or changed (and does not belong to GAMC). A Website could cost \$1000 to set up with ongoing annual costs of \$1000. A Facebook page is already set up (and is free). It should be moderated heavily. Guidelines are required. Laraine Callinan reported that Jenny Fawbett (CHMC) is willing to help set up a Website.

Facebook pages - (there are currently two). One could be closed and access to the other tightly controlled (Members only). There are Privacy issues, including rego numbers on our special historic vehicles. Control advanced event notice (of when and where) would be required. Approval of those in images is required. Andrew Morton has expressed interest in being involved.

Darryl Dunn will find out what is required to set up a Google account. The GAMC would probably have to change

the current email address. The president was complemented on her use of mobile phone messages (as every membership has a mobile phone).

The Secretary reminded those present that Communication was important and some members do not have or want to use the internet.

<u>Rego Day</u>: Saturday/Sunday November 9/10, 2024 – was successful. There were no major problems.

<u>Christmas Party:</u> Saturday, December 7, 2024 at Coolac. Jim Morton has most aspects organised. Members to bring salad and sweets, secret Santa gift and something for hamper. (see November magazine for details).


WELFARE – The club committee wishes members and friends all the best for Christmas with a Happy New Year, stay safe and enjoy the festive season.
