Due to the possibility of COVID-19 restrictions and limitations being placed on our activities, the Management Committee recommend the following advice be offered to our members who may be contemplating taking part in Club activities in the future.

It is now intended to make use of the IMPROMPTU EVENT for use by members for other members.

In order to do so, our website has an Application Form that when fully completed is automatically sent to the Events Co-ordinator.

His job will then require resending the Application as an email to ALL members.

Accordingly, the Application will require a start time and those members wishing to take part in the Event will need to phone the Applicant to obtain the requisite details.

It is anticipated that these Impromptu Events will often take place during mid-week.

#### WEARING OF SEAT BELTS—CLASSIC VEHICLES

The government camera scheme to detect wearing of seatbelts has been clarified by the Transport Main Roads with respect to wearing them whilst in a Classic car built prior to 1969 (when seat-belts were not installed when manufactured). A representative of the TMR has stated that all photos taken are cross-referenced with the vehicle registration details and if the vehicle is prior to 1969 and NO belts were fitted, NO FURTHER ACTION WOULD OCCUR—THE PHOTO WOULD BE DISMISSED.

However, if a photo was inadvertently processed and a summons was issued, contact TMR and they will deal with it in your favour.



It is our duty to remind Members who are on S.I.V.S Concessional Registration that Department of Transport and Main Roads conditions state "to retain the concession you should be a financial member of an incorporated car club. If you operate outside of these conditions of the SIV Scheme, you may face a fine of \$176 or risk having your concession eligibility reassessed. As well as incurring financial penalties for operating outside of the scheme, you may face serious insurance implications if you are involved in an incident causing damage to your or other vehicles or property, or injury to yourself or others whilst not being compliant with registration requirements due to lapsed membership.

- an understanding of the role of the Committee and their role within it
- leadership skills and willingness to accept responsibility
- listening skills
- the ability to use the technology the club uses to communicate to its members

#### The President

The President plays a crucial role and this function can be the most entertaining and satisfying of all roles. The President must see that the meetings run smoothly by leading discussion and ensuring that speakers are not repetitious or stray from the topic. It is the President's role to offer a balanced discussion and summarise points of view before asking members to vote. Duties: ☐ Chair General and Committee Meetings, ☐ Provide policy direction and advice, ☐ Allocate resources to Club projects, ☐ Co-sign cheques as required, ☐ Oversee the organisation of Club activities, ☐ Key point contact for Club members, CAMS, Government Agencies and the general public, ☐ The President must be reasonably easy to contact at home and at work, be able to get along with people and have a genuine commitment to the long-term interests of the Club. ☐ Handle correspondence The Vice-President The Vice President's role is to: Chair meeting in the absence of the President. Assist the President in the President's other duties. The Secretary The successful Club depends on the Secretary who is the linchpin in the organisation. The Secretary's basic roles are to keep records of the organisation. The Secretary, in association with the President calls meetings and distributes the agenda. Keeping a record of meetings by taking minutes is an essential responsibility and should be completed soon after an item is raised. The minutes should be available to all members within 3 days of the meeting, including publication on the website. The Secretary will have good organisational skills and an eye for detail. **Duties:** □ Organise and keep up to date the Club's records and files. ☐ Record minutes of General and Committee meetings.

☐ In consultation with the President, deal with Club correspondence.

The Events Co-ordinator is responsible for the promotion of the Club on social media and managing club events as required. Excellent communication skills and a friendly attitude are essential for this role.

□ Promote awareness of the Club events and activities.
□ Respond to queries and messages raised on social media platforms
□ Manage event organisation and logistics, including trophy coordination
☐ Liaise with the Webmaster to align event information
□ Work with social media and event liaisons

Assist in the organisation of Club projects when and where required.

2024 will see the first Macs Bridge to be hosted at the Caboolture Aero Club on July 14 2024.


