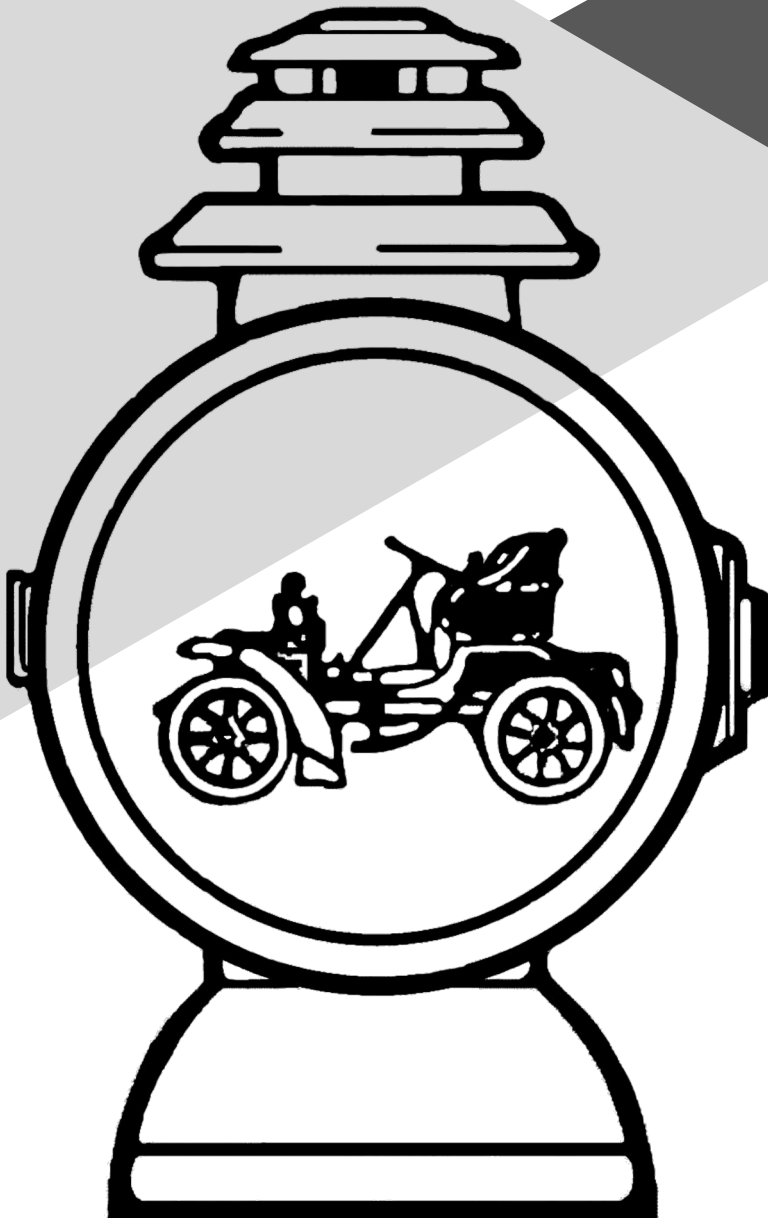

## GUNDAGAI TRACTOR PULL

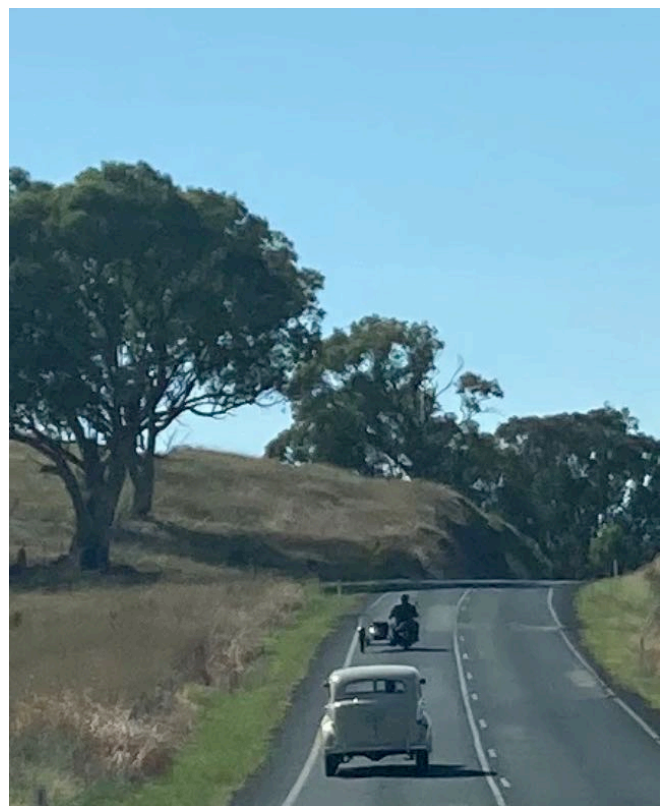
Horse and Dressage displays were also on the agenda.
