- . **RUNS & SOCIAL:** Matthew Ware reported the last mid-week rally was well Attended, a very scenic trip to Walloon 21 Cars 41 People.
- . **TRACTOR TREK:** Merv Hodges reports all was well.
- . **QHMC:** David Jones has not been able to attend owing to work Commitments. He has asked if any Members could take over this position, as he cannot see his work changing.
- . **DATING:** Gordon Russ has dated two cars. An M.G & Mercedes.
- . **LADIES RUN:** Joan Besch reported the date would be the 7th June, and The venue arranged and booked.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Tom Mulchay asked if the Club had had an invitation from The Pioneer Village to attend the Australia Day Celebrations at the Pioneer Village? The secretary had to answer no, which surprised Tom, as he thought we should have received one.

On a show of hands it was decided that 9 cars would go to Laidley. While 9 would go to Gatton for the celebrations.

QHMC PROPOSED RALLY 2021: Robin Lamb handed out to members the report he put together after the Feasibility Committee had done their research as to the feasibility of running this Rally.

President David Jones asked questions, 1. Do we have the willing man power?

Robin answered he could not see a problem as we have many Club Members capable of handling such an event.

2. Date. The dates decided on is the 11th, 12th, 13th June 2021. Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

All agreeable that this is a suitable date, as it is a long week-end.

3. How will it effect our Rally.?

Robins Answer. He did not see it effecting our Club Rally as it will be run separately.

4. How will the turnover from the QHMC rally effect our turn over in relation to The Office of FairTrading levels.

Robins Answer: He predicted that we would exceed the \$20,000.00 limit with or without the QHMC Rally. This means we will have to have our books audited by an accountant.

A discussion was then held as to how much an Audit would cost. Tom Mulchay said the Pioneer Village had to pay an accountant \$600.00 on their \$40,000.00 turn over and the Audit resulting in Nil Tax.

Elise Pakeman said another Club she was involved with paid \$800.00 for their books Audit.

Allan Brimblecombe remarked he thought, especially if the drought continued, it would be a benefit to the area to bring people in.

David played Devils Advocate very well and got all questions answers to the satisfaction of the Meeting.

A Secret Ballot was then held. Joan Besch handed out paper and pencils and David appointed Elaine Pakeman and Ian Williams as counters of the votes.

The result of the vote was 40 FOR 13 NO's and 2 Invalid.

Robin Lamb moved, seconded Merv Hodges that the QHMC Rally for 2021 go ahead.

And the secretary notifies QHMC of the meetings decision. Carried.

Matthew Ware moved. That Robin Lamb be elected as QHMC Rally coordinator and that he approach members to be part of the committee. Seconded, Gordon Russ. Carried.

Matthew continued as there were no more nominations for the position: There are a lot of members who have the experience in running large Rallies, including Tractor Treks and organizing catering for large groups of people. It would be essential that the assistant Secretary/Treasurer be part of the committee, so as not to put an added work load on our Secretary and Treasurer, as there would be a lot of paper work involved.

Robin asked for time to approach members and put together his Committee, and agreed that the Assistant Sec/Treasure be part of the committee,

President asked that All communications be via the club secretary and tabled at the monthly meeting. These emails etc. to be archived for reference purposes.

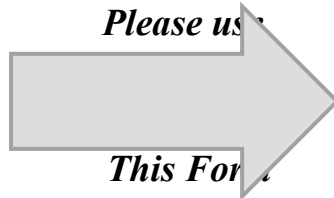
***Toowoomba Darling Downs & Vintage Motor Club 50th Anniversary Celebrations

So far I have replaced the original engine with a much better one, rebuilt the fuel pump, alternator, and starter, rebuilt the twin Stromberg's, cleaned up the engine bay and fitted a reconditioned Borg 35. The exhaust that is on it needs replacing. I only put it back on so I could drive it in and out of the shed without upsetting the neighbours too much. The car starts and runs ok but still needs a little bit finer tuning. Some new fuel would help also.

The body is very sound with just a little surface rust. The chassie is very good. Inside needs work, The seats are good just a small amount of stitching coming away on the top of the back seat. There is a rebuilt dash with LED lights still needs paint or veneer.

The replacement engine came out of a complete parts car which is included in the sale. There are parts, parts, and more parts. All are included, what does not go with the car will go to the scrap man.
